



**How to do:** Please prepare a gauge before you start to knit and calculate the stitches accordingly. Take a cardigan of your own and measure the length and width and calculate the stitches according to the gauge and measurements. Arrange the pattern by starting from the middle of your knitting piece and adapt the knitting pattern properly. Please observe that just the forward series are shown in the pattern. The backward series have to be knit like they appear. Always compare the form of your knitting piece with your own cardigan and follow the edges by linking and chaining off the redundant stitches.

**Meaning of the figures and symbols:**

-	purl	
1	plain stitch	
3/3	knop	Take an extra knitting needle and knit three stitches out of one. Knit three lines immediately by ignoring the rest of your knitting piece and link these three stitches to one again. Then continue with the rest of your knitting piece like just lay the thread over your knitting needle without stitching it.
0	rollover	Just lay the thread over your knitting needle without stitching it.
A	link stitch	Link two stitches and overlay it to the right side
B	link stitch	Link two stitches and overlay it to the left side.
1 1	plat	Take four stitches on an extra needle and cross these stitches with the next four stitches. Knit these next stitches and then take the stitches from the extra needle back to your normal knitting needle and continue.
